

Water: Sample Action Plan Report

Ms. Waters' 6th Grade Class, XYZ Academy

After doing the water worksheet and water audit assessment of water-using fixtures in and near their classroom, the students observed that the faucet in their classroom was leaking and the drinking fountain next to their classroom was constantly running. The students also noticed that many of their schoolmates were letting the water run while they were washing their hands. Additionally, the water coming from the faucets took a long time to warm up, so students were washing their hands with cold water.

In order to solve this problem the class determined that they needed to come up with a way to let maintenance staff know about malfunctioning fixtures, and a way to let other students know about how to reduce water waste.

The class determined that they needed a maintenance notification system and needed to launch a campus-wide education campaign to start changing students' and staff's water use habits.

Students will take action by notifying maintenance staff of the faucet leak and running water fountain, and will work with maintenance staff to establish a reporting system for students and staff. Students will also create signs to put above every sink and water fountain, to remind other students to turn off the water when it's not being used. Lastly, students will pledge to remind each other about saving water when they see it being wasted. Students will be responsible for educating other students about the importance of water conservation and the impact of water waste at their school.
