

Sample Action Plan Report

After doing the waste assessments of their classroom and library the students observed paper that could be recycled in the trash receptacles. The students also noticed that the recycling bins being used were old cardboard boxes without labels and they were not paired next to the trash receptacles. Additionally, single-sided paper was not being reused as scratch paper in the classroom or library.

In order to solve this problem the class determined that they needed better recycling bins for their classroom and the library. They also needed to label the recycling bins and pair them next to the trash receptacles.

The class determined that they needed a container for collecting single-sided paper in the classroom and library, so it can be used as scratch paper for drawing.

Students will take action by labeling new recycling bins, create posters to encourage recycling in the classroom and library, and make single-sided paper collection containers for the library and their classroom.
