

Sample Celebrate and Share for Water

Teams of students present what they did for their GSS project to one another. The teams created signs to encourage reporting leaks, posters to encourage saving water when washing hands, and morning announcements to educate other students on how to conserve and preserve water. During their presentations, teams will explain to one another the effects their actions will have in helping the environment.

The teacher also shares with students the certificate that they will receive from GSS, and explains that this is a way for the County to recognize their “job well done” for making a difference in their school. Additionally, to celebrate their success, students may have a healthy potluck-style snack time organized by one or more parent volunteers.
